Lincolnshire County Council – Section 19 Flood Investigations

Lincolnshire County Council (LCC) is currently undertaking investigative works into the recent flooding issues that have been experienced by residents in the area following storms Babet and Henk. LCC have contracted and authorised flood risk consultants to undertake this work on behalf of the council.

From the beginning of March and continuing for several months, consultants will be out in the affected locations to engage with residents who have reported internal flooding during the recent storms, and to determine potential mechanisms for the floods for the section 19 reports.

Any access to properties, whether internal or external, or documenting of evidence such as photographs will only be undertaken by express permission of the homeowner in question beforehand.
