## **Public Access Defibrillators**



These are located outside the Parish Office (between the Black Bull and the Paper Shop), on the exterior of the Sports & Social Club on the Ryland Road playing field, at the rear of the pavilion at Manor Park, Village Hall, St Mary's Primary School, William Farr School, Stonecliff **Park** (near the entrance to the social club) and the **Vets** on Ryland Road.

These are for the benefit of those living in or visiting the village, although we hope they are never used, they are there to save lives in an emergency. No training is required to use one; just dial 999 and you will be given the code to access the defibrillator which will then talk you through how to use it.

If you have a dog, you're probably well aware that dogs die in hot cars. You may not know that dogs may also die on hot walks. The RSPCA website has some useful information on keeping pets cool in the summer months.

When exercising dogs on the playing fields, please keep them on a lead and be alert as to where they leave their mess and clean up after them, there are plenty of dog bins provided. When walking around the village please clean up and make sure the footpaths are kept free from dog poo.

#### **Noise and Litter**



Now that the summer evenings are upon us, please be mindful of playing loud music and not disturbing your neighbours who are equally trying to enjoy the peaceful environment of living in a rural village;

remind your children when they are out and about on the playing fields too and to pick up their litter – there are plenty of bins provided.
