Music & Arts Festival



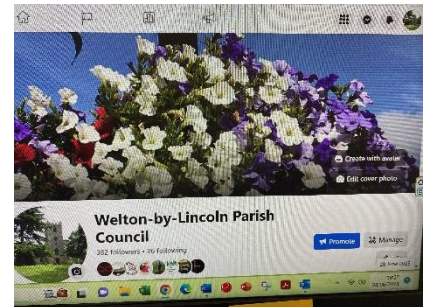
