

The Central Lincolnshire Local Plan (CLLP) was adopted by the Central Lincolnshire Joint Strategic Planning Committee (CLJSPC) on 24 April 2017 and replaced the Local Plans of the City of Lincoln, West Lindsey and North Kesteven District Councils. Policy LP4 of the CLLP provides a strategic steer as to what level of growth over the plan period is appropriate for all small and medium villages (as identified in the Settlement Hierarchy in Policy LP2). West Lindsey District Council provides a monitoring note of the latest position on permissions and completions and remaining growth level for each listed village in its area.

The Local Plan Review 2019 proposes to replace the Local Plan adopted in 2017. It addresses a range of issues such as climate change, housing, employment, shopping and more. The review was begun with an Issues and Options consultation undertaken in June and July 2019 followed by a Draft Local Plan consultation undertaken between 30 June and 24 August 2021 and is expected to be finalised later this year. The new CLLP will dictate where residential properties will be built and Welton will have a number of allocated sites giving the number of houses for each location, currently as follows:

WL/WELT/001A Prebend Lane - 195 WL/WELT/003 Land at The Hardings - 50 (Planning Permission granted) WL/WELT/007 Land east of Prebend Lane - 104 WL/WELT/008A Land north of 77 Eastfield Lane - 109 WL/WELT/011 Land to East of Prebend Lane - Under construction 288

What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

Neighbourhood planning was introduced in the Localism Act 2011. It is an important and powerful tool that gives communities statutory powers to shape how their communities develop. In very simple terms, a Neighbourhood Plan is:

- A document that sets out planning policies for the neighbourhood area planning policies are used to decide whether to approve planning applications
- Written by the local community, the people who know and love the area, rather than the Local Planning Authority
- A powerful tool to ensure the community gets the right types of development, in the right place

This questionnaire will greatly assist in the compilation of a new Neighbourhood Plan, and we would be grateful if you could spare a few minutes to complete it. The questionnaire will be used to understand what the community opinion is as a whole and provide the basis of the plan, as a reflection of the consensus of the residents of Welton.

The new Neighbourhood Plan will have to proceed through all the processes that the original plan did and if voted on at the referendum stage (there must be a 50% 'yes' response), will be adopted by WLDC which means that we will have more say on planning applications. Neighbourhood planning is not just about property development; it is about local people coming together to agree what you want our village to look like, where you want new homes to be built and how they should look, where shops, offices and green spaces should be located, resulting in better facilities for the whole community.
