Bleed Kits

You may have noticed that three red cabinets have been installed outside the Parish Office, at the rear of the pavilion at Manor Park and on the exterior of the Sports & Social Club at Ryland Road near the defibrillators. Bleed control kits are specialised, public-access medical kits designed to manage life-threatening, catastrophic bleeding from accidents, stabbings, or gunshots within the first few minutes before the emergency services arrive. They typically contain tourniquets, haemostatic dressings, chest seals, and protective gear. These kits are meant for anyone to use, without training, to treat serious, life-threatening injuries and contain instructions on how to use them; the emergency services will talk you through using them after dialing 999 to obtain the access code.
