You are invited to drop in anytime during these hours to see and hear some ideas for the use of the land; but more importantly we want **your** suggestions and wishes for the future use of the land. This is **your** opportunity to have **your** say, come along anytime from 3.30pm until 7.00pm when the official business of the meeting and presentations will take place. Welton Country Park is the temporary name for the 22 acres of land to be transferred to the PC by Beal Homes. Councillors and officers from WLDC will be on hand to speak to you together with representatives from Welton & Dunholme Cricket Club and Welton Football Club. The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group will also provide an update on how they are progressing with re-writing the plan. Refreshments will be served from 6.30pm.

The Beck - Weil's disease

Please do not let your children or dogs play in the beck. There is a risk of catching Weil's disease which is a form of a bacterial infection also known as Leptospirosis that is carried by animals, most commonly in rats and cattle. It can be contracted from contact with any fresh or untreated water including ponds, canals, lakes and rivers, as well as flood waters that are contaminated.
