Facilities Assistant

The council is looking for someone to provide a supporting role to our Facilities Team. Duties will include building and grounds maintenance, setting out and clearing away of furniture, litter collection and emptying bins, snow clearing, and many other tasks required on a daily basis. To attend job related training, as required. The successful applicant should have a flexible approach to working days and hours including some evenings and weekends and be able to cover for holidays and/or sickness when required. Must have a clean Full Driving Licence. Working 10 hours per week over 2 days at the current rate of £12.71 per hour.

Riparian Ownership – Does your property back onto the beck?

Riparian ownership refers to the legal rights and responsibilities associated with owning land adjacent to a watercourse, like a river, stream, or ditch. It essentially grants landowners rights to the watercourse and its associated waters. Riparian owners typically own the land up to the center of the watercourse, unless otherwise specified in property deeds. Riparian owners are responsible for maintaining the watercourse, including removing blockages that impede the flow of water or could cause flooding. Please do not dispose of garden rubbish in the beck or allow dogs to roam freely to increase the chances of wild trout returning to the watercourse and to support the wonderful work carried out by the Wild Trout Trust.
