- a. Increase in wages for members of staff to take effect from 1st April 2024 in line with the National Living Wage of £11.44 per hour, an increase of 9.7%, pro-rata for the Facilities Manager and a minimum of 4.5% for the administration team subject to NJC Scales normally received in October/November. All as voted at Full Council in November 2023.
- b.
